

The 8 rules of syntax every Greek student should know

1. Indirect statement - ὅτι/ὥς
 - tense of the original
 - can be in optative in secondary sequence

2. Purpose clauses - ἵνα/ὥς/ὅπως/ὄφρα
 - subjunctive in primary sequence
 - optative in secondary sequence

3. Result clauses - ὥστε
 - indicative (result fulfilled)
 - infinitive (left unstated)

- 4 x conditionals

8. Indefinite clauses - conditional, relative, temporal
 - ἄν
 - subjunctive (for present generic)
