  - διδασκω       I teach

### Genitive

- Possessive
- Partitive
- Agent
- Time within which
- Quality/consisting of
- Comparison
- Origin/source
- Hearing
- Sociative (after μετα)
- Absolute
- With certain verbs/prepositions:
  - άκουω            I hear
  - λαμβανομαι    I seize, take hold
  - καταδικάζω     I condemn
  - άξιος             worthy of
  - αίτιος            responsible for
  - πλεως            full of

### Dative

- Indirect object
- (Dis)advantage
  - Ethic
  - Possession
  - Time/place at which
  - Instrument
  - Manner
- With certain words:

λογωι μεν....έργωι δε	in word...but in fact....
χραομαι	I use, have to do with
πειθομαι	I obey, have trust in
έπομαι	I follow
δοκει μοι	It seems to me
όμοιος	resembling
