

## Conditional sentences in Greek

Real	Unreal
	εἰ aorist indic, aor indic + ἄν If I had seen him I would have said...
	εἰ imp indic, imp + ἄν If I were at home now, I would be...
ἐάν + subj, fut indic If it rains I'll take an umbrella	εἰ + opt, opt + ἄν If I were to win (won) the lottery I would...

### Notes

- Future real (also = future more vivid) can have future in protasis, particularly for threats or if repeating what someone has just said.
- The 'tenses' of the subjunctive and optative differ only aspectually (contrast with Latin)
- Past and present real clauses = indicative in both clauses.
- Mixed conditionals use the protasis of one type with the apodosis of another.  
Rare to switch between real and unreal here.
