οἴμοι· πέπυσται τὸν ἐμὸν ἔκθετον γόνον;  
πόθεν ποτ’; ὦ δύστηνος, ὡς ἀπωλόμην.

*Alas. Have they discovered the child I sent away? Where on earth from? Wretched me, I am ruined.*

οὐ γὰρ ἔδειςά κω μὴ ἐσσωθέωμεν ὑπὸ Σκυθέων μάχη, ἀλλὰ μᾶλλον μὴ οὐ δυνάμενοι  
σφέας εὐρεῖν πάθωμεν τι ἀλώμενοι.

*I was not in any sense worried that we may be beaten in battle against the Scythians, but only that we would not be able to find them and then that we may suffer something as we wander around.*
