

Examples of the objective genitive

σὺ δὲ τότε μὲν ἐκαλλωπίζου ὡς οὐκ ἀγανακτῶν εἰ δέοι τεθνάναι σε, ἀλλὰ ἥροῦ, ὡς
ἔφησθα, πρὸ τῆς φυγῆς θάνατον·

But you then put on airs and said you were not disturbed if you must die, and you preferred, as you said, death to exile.

οὐ γὰρ ἂν δέσποιν' ἐμὴ
Μήδεια πύργους γῆς ἔπλευσ' Ἰωλκίας
ἔρωτι θυμὸν ἐκπλαγεῖσ' Ἰάσονος·

For then my lady Medea would not have sailed to the towers of Iolcus, her heart smitten with love for Jason,
