

## Examples of the potential indicative

καίτοι πόθεν κλέος γ' ἂν εὐκλέεστερον κατέσχον ἢ τὸν αὐτάδελφον ἐν τάφῳ τιθεῖσα;

*And yet how would I have got a more glorious reputation than by burying my brother?*

Sophocles Antigone 502-4

οὐ γὰρ ἂν δέσποιν' ἐμὴ

Μήδεια πύργους γῆς ἔπλευσ' Ἰωλκίας

ἔρωτι θυμὸν ἐκπλαγεῖσ' Ἰάσονος

*For then my lady Medea would not have sailed to the towers of Iolcus, her heart smitten with love for Jason,*

τί τοῦδ' ἂν εὕρημ' ἡὔρον εὐτυχέστερον

ἢ παῖδα γῆμαι βασιλέως φυγὰς γεγώς;

*What better luck could I have found than marrying the daughter of the king, though an exile?*
